Protocol of the exchange of the instruments of ratification by Canada and the United States of the Convention for the avoidance of double taxation and the prevention of fiscal evasion in the case of estate taxes and succession duties signed at Ottawa, June 8, 1944, and Washington, February 6, 1945.
- 2. Exchange of notes between Canada and Brazil recording an agreement relating to military service, Rio de Janeiro, February 9, 1945.
- Morthern Ireland, Canada, Australia, New Zealand, the Union of South Africa and India on the one hand and the Union of Socialist Republics on the other hand, relating to prisoners of War and civilians liberated by forces operating under Soviet command and forces operating under British command, signed at the Crimea on February 11, 1945.
- 4. Exchange of notes between Canada and the United States constituting an agreement respecting air services of the armed forces of the two countries, Ottawa, February 13, 1945.
