\$48.1 million and will be met in roughly equal amounts out of funds available to the External Aid Office and the Export Credits Insurance Corporation. The funds will be provided as required over the five year construction period.

Both Canada and Pakistan are committed to using atomic energy solely for peaceful purposes and have declared their support for the safeguards system developed by the International Atomic Energy Agency. In the agreement just signed in Karachi. Canada and Pakistan have undertaken to avail themselves of this service and it is anticipated that the Pakistan and Canadian Governments will proceed shortly to make arrangements for the Agency to assume the task of applying safeguards to the Karachi reactor.
