Mr. Fisher, seconded by Mr. Knowles, moved,—That an Order of the House do issue for a copy of all correspondence between the RCMP Commissioner's Office or that of the "I" Directorate Office and the Alert Service (Marjorie Lamb, P.O. Box 173, Station "Q", Toronto, Ontario), since June 1st, 1961.—(*Notice of motion for the Production of Papers No. 112*).
