

4. Page 8, line 14. Strike out the words "two years'" and substitute the words "six months'".

5. Page 8, line 25. Strike out the words "two years'" and substitute the words "six months'".

6. Page 8, line 28. Strike out the word "three" and substitute the word "one".

7. Page 9, lines 38 and 39. Strike out the words "gold or silver" and substitute the words "gold, silver, platinum or other precious metals".

By leave of the House, on motion of Mr. Rinfret, the House reverted to Motions.

Mr. Rinfret, a Member of the King's Privy Council, then presented,—Return to an Order of the House of May 9, 1938, for a return showing the names of concerns who tendered for the erection of the Bartman dam, the amount of each tender, the name of the successful tenderer, the amount paid to date to the company that built such dam. Also a copy of the specifications in connection with this work, and a statement as to whether or not the construction was done according to specifications.

Also,—Return to an Order of the House of May 16, 1938, for a copy of all correspondence exchanged between the Minister of Agriculture, the Independent Millers of Saskatchewan and other persons regarding proposals for the provision of relief flour during the year 1937.

And also,—Return to an Address to His Excellency the Governor General of May 30, 1938, for a copy of all letters, telegrams, reports, Orders in Council and other documents, dated from April 1, 1930, to date, in connection with the reclamation of the Kootenay Flats at or near Kootenay Landing, British Columbia.

The amendments made by the Senate to Bill No. 137, An Act to amend the Criminal Code, were taken into consideration and agreed to.

By leave of the House, on motion of Mr. Mackenzie King, it was resolved,—That the House shall not be adjourned at 11 o'clock, p.m., this day.

The House resolved itself again into Committee of Supply.
