TRAVEL BUREAU

(a) Arrangements have been made with THE WAYFARERS TRAVEL AGENCY (London) to supply delegates attending the British Commonwealth Education Conference with such tickets as they require in Great Britain at the reduced Conference rate. These tickets should be from the port of disembarkation to the port of embarkation in the case of visitors to this country, and from the place of residence to London and return in the case of home delegates.
