
Referring to the Comptroller's letter of July 21st regarding the increase of fees approved by the Board of Governors for the Session 1932-33, may I call your attention to the fact that, at the meeting of Corporation held to consider this question, you stated that the Library School was not included in the proposal. I notice that an increase of \$50.00 has, however, been applied to the \$150.00 already charged by the Library School.

I am wondering whether this increase will cause any objection to be made on the part of the Carnegie Corporation which is financing the Library School and to which discrimination against American students might well appear to be anomalous.

As the Library School is not running at a deficit, may I suggest that this increase be reconsidered? If it is necessary to have this amount appear for purposes of comparison, is there any justifiable method of giving American Students a rebate?

I shall be glad to have your opinion and advice upon this matter.
