No error of statistics in any of the past editions has been discovered. But the publishers have reason to know that the "YEAR-BOOK" has been accepted as authority in Dominion matters, not only within the Dominion and the adjoining Provinces, but by public men in London, in Paris, in Washington, in Victoria, Vancouver Island, and in Melbourne, Australia. It has thus rendered public service and fulfilled its intended mission.

One edition will be sold at 12½ cents; another, with a showing of the line of the proposed Red River and Pacific Railways, the Intercolonial, and the railway system of Canada, for 25 cents.
