- Totchikala*, a village of Unalaska, 138.
- Trapeznikoff (Nikiphor)*, Boris and Glebb, a vessel fitted out by him, her voyage and return, 39, 40, &c. Another vessel fitted out by him destroyed, and the crew cut off, by the natives of Unimak, 140.
- Tsaaduck*, a kind of lamp, 150.
- Tsaudsing*, a Chinese idol, 226.
- Tschirikoff*. See *Beering*.
- Tschuffovaia* (a river). See *Stroganoff*.
- Tschutski*, a people on the river Anadyr, 43. Boundaries of their country, 293. See *Asia*.
- Tschukotskoi Nefs*, the N. E. cape of the country of the Tschutski, 293. Stadukin and Soliverstoff claim the discovery of the passage round that promontory, 314. See *Deshtneff*, *Svatoi Nefs*, *Sbelatskoi Nefs*; see also p. 322.
