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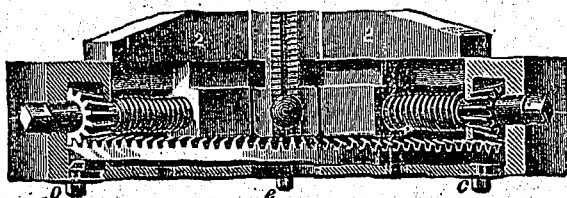


Fig. 6, No. 2. Or Inside Jaw.

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
