A better demand for steel products is generally reported, but to-day's rise in values should discount a lot of improvement in the business of these companies, if previous quotations represented former conditions quotations represented former conditions and the morning board. The price commenced at 59% and concluded at 63%, a reminiscence of some of the former evolutions of the stock. The advance was regarded as mighly manipulated and susceptible to a free movement in either directions from the closing price. In the steels there was less ching, but both Nova Scotia and Dominion aregistered a quick upward turn on the day's business. In the balance of the list there were no striking features. Decisions in suits in which Telephone and Toronto rails were respectively concerned had no particular influence on values. C.P.R. was held higher here and in outside markets.
