SUBURBAN SERVICE ON THE I.C.R. IS CUT OFF

The blow has fallen. The I. C. R. suburban service is to be abolished. City men residing in the suburbs who are required to observe ordinary business hours are facing a situation of the utmost seriousness.

The announcement was made today that, commencing on Sunday, the entire suburban train service would be abolished by the Sussex and through trains. This does not provide facilities which will allow the average man to get into the city to his work and return home in the evening and what they are to do is left to themselves to figure out. Probably the majority of those who live in the suburbs throughout the year own their own houses and the elimination of the train service which may make it necessary to remove to the city and rent houses here, will leave them with unsalable houses on their hands.

It has been announced already that the trains connecting with the Maritime Express at Moncton, arriving in the morning at 11.20 and departing at 6.10 p. m., will be cancelled. Today the additional announcement is made that the suburban trains will be taken off. This does away with the train arriving in the city at 7.45 a. m., leaving at 11.20 a. m., arriving again at 8 p. m., and leaving at 11 p. m.
