

TWO NAMED FOR MUNICIPAL BOARD

The executive of the Women's Council yesterday nominated Miss M. H. McCloskey and Mrs. J. D. Seely for appointment on the Municipal Home Board, and was urged to take a strong

stand for the appointment of a woman factory inspector. It named its nominations for the officers of the National Council to be elected in Toronto in October.

Mrs. J. H. Doody, first vice-president, was in the chair, in the absence of Mrs. A. W. Estey. Mrs. T. H. Carter acted as secretary.

The council was asked to make nominations for the National Council annual meeting in Toronto in October. Mrs. E. Atherton Smith, honorary president, who is on a world cruise, sent greetings. The North End C. W.

L. wrote to name Miss M. H. McCloskey as the council's nominee for the Municipal Home Board. Because of the future absence Mrs. J. S. Flaglor resigned as nominee for the board. Mrs. T. Wilford Campbell, convenor, sent the report of the finance committee. Mrs. Estey, president, sent regrets at inability to attend and suggested sending flowers to Miss Alice Estey, treasurer, and greetings on arrival in Canada to Mrs. E. Atherton Smith. Nominations for the National Council of Women were received as follows:

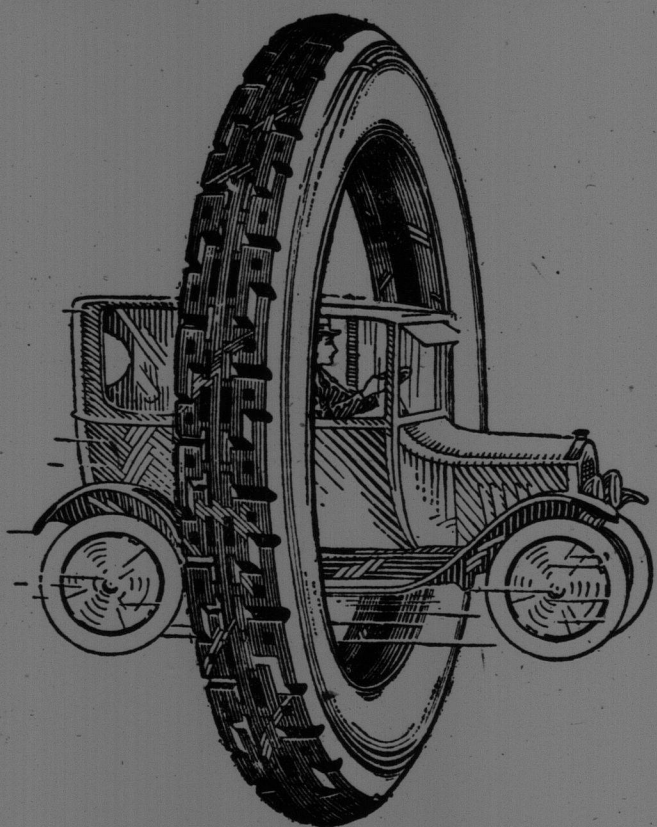
