

STERNE'S EUREKA Singeing Lamp for Horses & Cattle

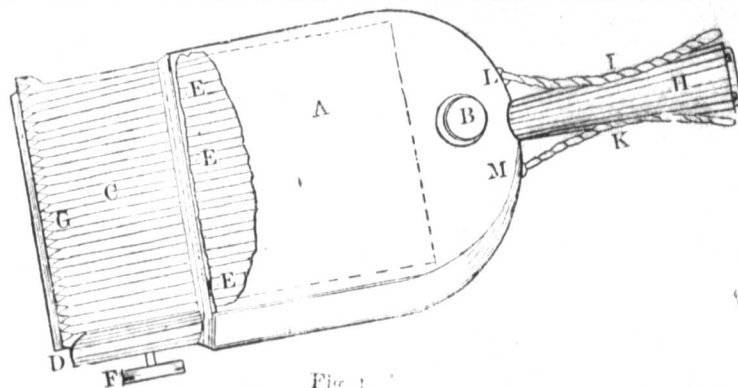

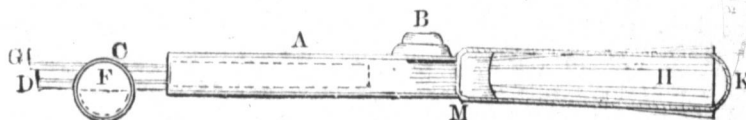

Fig 1, is a top view of the lamp.

Fig 2, is a side view of the same; A, is the flask or case for oil; B, is a screwed hole for filling flask, the cover being screwed on it; C, is a flat tube in front of flask A and passing inside to near the bottom of flask in tube C, the wick D is placed on one side of tube C in the inside of flask A, any number of holes E are formed to admit the oil to the wick when the machine is worked downwards. F, is a thumb wheel and shaft, having any number of toothed wheels fastened on it, they are covered in a case in tube C, and work wick D out or in as required. G, is a comb fastened on the end of tube C and projecting over wick D, by it the hair is raised in front of the blaze. H, is the handle attached to flask A.
