

WITNESS CROSS-EXAMINED BY THE PROSECUTOR (Cont'd):

A- His right hand.

Q- And you say in the space of 50 seconds he let go of him again?

A- Yes.

Q- Did the Corporal shove Lamonte around at all?

A- He just shoved him back against the bed, that is all.

Q- Did you take your eyes off either of them?

A- No, sir.

Q- You were just standing there watching?

A- Yes, sir.

A- Yes.
