STRATFORD PUDDING

Operations in New Zealand, 1846-7 (men-tioned in despatches and medals); served as a volunteer in the Southall rebellion in India, 1855 (received thanks of the Indian Government); Indian mutiny, 1857-8, as orderly officer at Sultanpore, and subse-quent affairs on the advance to Lucknow, by the force under General Franks (three times mentioned in despatches); as alde-de-camp at the siege and capture of Luck. delicious.)

SPLENDID GINGER BEER Five gallons of water, one-half pound ginger root boiled, four pounds of sugar, one-eighth pound of oream of tartar, one bottle of essence of lemon, one ounce of tartaric acid, one quart of yeast. KNITED EDGING.

Cast on seven stitches. Knit 1st row : 3 plain, thread over, knit 2 together, over, 1 plain, over, 1 plain, 2nd row : All plain knitting. 3rd row : 3 plain, over, knit 2 together, 2 plain, over, 1 plain, over, 1 plain. 4th row : Cast off till there is 1 stitch on right hand needle and 6 on the left 6 plain. left, 6 plain
