

Page 17. The king of Prussia will acknowledge the French republic, and also make peace with it.

It is reported he has already made peace; if he has not, in all probability he soon will.

18. Russia will also quarrel with the Poles, and devour great numbers of them; Warfaw will be set on fire, and the government entirely changed.

In the Leyden Gazette, Dec. 26, 1794, it says, in the accounts from Warfaw, "That the attack began at five o'clock in the morning; at nine the enemy was in possession of the place. Five thousand Poles were slain in the assault, the remaining 5000 were taken prisoners or dispersed. After this was over, and every thing appeared to be quiet, ten hours after all resistance had ceased, about nine o'clock at night, they set fire to the town, and began to butcher the inhabitants. The sick and wounded perished in the flames; the rest, old men, women, and children, fell by the sword. Nine thousand persons of every age and of both sexes, are computed to have fallen in the massacre, and the whole of the suburb, except a few scattered houses, was reduced to ashes.
