

Ottawa 19th March 1894-

Sir,

With reference to my letter to you of the 28th ultimo, I find that the Indians of Coccoocache have expressed their willingness to accept a Reserve at a point called Grand de Tour or downwards on the North side of the St. Maurice. The selection of the sites for the Reserves to be allotted the Tete de Boule, Algonquin and Abenakis Indians is therefore completed, viz

7 396 acres at Weymoutachingue-

380 " at Coccoocache

8 360 " for the Abenakis

between the points marked "A" and "B" on the Plan which accompanied my letter to you of the 28th ultimo.

Instructions will accordingly be given a Surveyor of this Department to have these Reserves surveyed during the present year.
