Camp Borden, Ont.	11-5-40		Honorary Flight Lieutenant L.A. Costello, R.C. Chaplain, posted this Station. Arrived by private car 1400 hours this date.	
Camp Borden, Ont.	12-5-40		Church Parades: Roman Catholic - 0845 hours; Protestant - 0945 hours. This is Mothers' Day.
