asserfaction since my last enoquetion, I was Surprised to find the agent-chawing rations for himself- and family as I was not aware that the order to do so had bee usued nor do I know that there are any supplies on hand for the purpose: I was also under the impression that an agent should Cease to draw-living allowence when travelling to his reserves as soon as he commenced to draw rations but this does not appear to be the care , as it now stands this agent draws full rations for himself and family, he Visits one arrow reserve of Farm 10. hetak with him for sulsistances upon the Journey the provisions furnished him by the Department and at the same time Charges two dollars a day, living allowonce and Seventy five Cents a day for his team ster who also draws Jull rations; I also
