Dear Mr. Meighen:

I am enclosing a letter prepared in answer to one received from Mr. Albert Cliffe of Lansdowne, Ont.

I have endeavored to point out that the Gatineau Power Co. uses a "zone" rate scheme, applying that rate over a district including urban and rural sections, which is not comparable with the Commission's scheme of supplying power at cost to rural communities as apart from urban communities.

The reply also points out that the Gatineau

Power Co. only makes extensions on its own choice, determined

primarily on the basis of whether it is economically ad
vantageous to do so, whereas the Commission extends its
