Sir,

Replying to your letter of the 19th instert, returning Cheque No. 1462, I beg to say that in view of the fact that you were to pay Dr. Rose that your expenses would have amounted to had you made the visit and these expense in March would have been \$18.00, it has been decided to pay your salary in full and a cheque for \$41.00 is being sent you.

In regard to the attendance given by you to the Ebb and Flow Lake Reserves, I beg to say that the Department is aware that you made a visit in March last but was it not the only visit you made to that reserve since the payments of 1914?

The Department quite realizes that it is impossible to give the Indians of Ebb and Flow Lake Reserve adequate attendance from such a distance as Portage la Prairie and the question of a change is not under consideration.
