Sir,-

I am in receipt of your letter of the 6th instant regarding your appointment as foreman in connection with the repairs to the agent's residence at St Regis, Que. and in reply I beg to give you hereunder the necessary instructions in connection with the proposed work, which you are to carry out for the Department at this building.

Before proceeding with any of the work the Department desires that you will consult with the agent, Mr. Faillon and arrange with him as to the best and most economical way of carrying out the work so that the sum of \$600.00, which has been appropriated for these repairs will, under no circumstances be exceeded, and also that the work may be begun where it is most urgently needed.

It is not the intention of the Department to supply any tools as these should be furnished by the workmen themselves.

Repairing of stone and brick work and reconstructing of the chimneys above roofs.

Reshingling of the kitchen roof and rebuilding of porches and cornices where necessary.
