The estimated value of work completed or under construction, including such services as sewers, water, roads and walks with storage shed accommodation for all houses; also Halifax and Moncton water development is \$80,911,267.00 which will provide:

- 18,350 houses (Ottawa #1 & 2 - 40 houses surplus)
- 15 hostels
- 65 staff houses (2 have been declared surplus Peterborough and Kingston)
Wallaceburg is being re-opened.
- 17 bunk houses
- 17 dining halls
- 29 schools
- 82 special buildings.

NOTE

- x Additional six wings to Men's Staff House erected under project #1, each wing consisting of 48 beds.
- xx Necessary alterations to aircraft plant formerly operated by Clarke Ruse Aircraft Limited, to provide sleeping and messing accommodation for R.C.A.F. personnel, being moved from Dartmouth so as to accommodate Shipyard Workers at Dartmouth.
- xxx In connection with the 112 houses proposed at Chalk River, 45 is the total now being moved from Nobel and Parry Sound. Working on moving balance from Arvida now.

PROJECT NO. 1 - DOMINION MAGNESIUM
