Certified copy of a Report of the Committee of the Privy Council, approved by His Excellency the Administrator on the 27th May, 1913.

The Committee of the Privy Council, on the recommendation of the Acting Superintendent General of Indian Affairs, advise, - with reference to Orders in Council of 31st March and 12th April, 1913, appointing Messrs Nathaniel White, J.A.J. McKenna, James Pearson Shaw, Day Hort Macdowell and Edward Ludlow Wetmore a Commission to adjust all matters relating to Indian affairs in the Province of British Columbia, - that, under subsection 1 of section 49 of the Indian Act, the said Commission be authorized to take from the Indians such surrenders as may be found necessary in order to complete or further the arrangements which the Commission are empowered to make; and that, under subsection 1 of the said section 49, Mr. J.G.H. Bergeron, the Secretary of the Commission, be authorized to take the necessary affidavits of execution of such surrenders.
