

South from Skeiktut and from a stream which
flows from three Lakes to Skeiktut.
* 50 inches from the Klinin River
* 50 inches from a stream which it is proposed to
dam which flows through the Reserve at the
68 mile post from Yale into the Thompson River.
* 20 inches from a small stream called Hodlin
which flows onto the Thompson River nearly
opposite the 67 mile post from Yale.
* 20 inches from a small stream called Shporota
which flows into the Thompson River nearly opposite
the 68 mile post from Yale.
* 20 inches from the stream called Shkum which
flows into the Thompson River close to the 70 mile
post from Yale and from the Entaltor or other
Lake on which it leads.
* 20 inches from a stream called Ara-lal-lat,
which runs in an easterly direction nearly up
to the West boundary line of the Klakout
Reserve which is nearly opposite the 72 mile
post from Yale. ~~and affords water for irrigation~~
* All the water on the lakes, ponds, springs,
marshes and streams within or partly within
or flowing through the Saguamish Reserve above
the Mandelie on the Left Bank of the Thompson
River is reserved for the use of the Indians
in irrigation.
