South from Skeikut and from a stream which flows from these Lakes to Skeikut.

- \* 50 inches from the Kiamin River
- \* 50 inches from a stream which it is proposed to dam which flows through the Reserve at the 65 mile post from Vale into the Thompson River
- \* 50 inches from a small stream called Shoshini which flows into the Thompson River nearly opposite the 67 mile post from Vale.
- \* 30 inches from a small stream called Akhpanota which flows into the Thompson River nearly opposite the 70 mile post from Vale
- \* 50 inches from the stream called Chakam which flows into the Thompson River close to the 70 mile post from Vale and from the Enhalto or other Lake in which it heads.
- \* 20 inches from a stream called Tera-lal-lak which runs in an easterly direction nearly up to the West boundary line of the Makowit Reserve which is nearly opposite the 72 mile post from Vale.

All the water on the lakes, ponds, springs, swamps and streams within or partly within or flowing through the Squiamy Reserve above the Mandelide on the left bank of the Thompson River is reserved for the use of the Indians in irrigation.
