DECLARATIONS OF NON-APPLICATION The following declarations apply to Canada's acceptance of the Agreement on Government Procurement with respect to the European Economic Community. (a) The Department of Post Office is included in the Canadian list of entities on the understanding that, should it cease to be a Government Department, the provisions of Article IX, paragraph 5(b) of the Agreement on Government Procurement would not apply. The Government of Canada does not, therefore, accept the declarations of the European Economic Community concerning the Canadian Post Office.
