*By His Excellency Major General
Sir JOHN HARVEY, Knight
Commander of the Most Hon-
ourable Military Order of the
Bath, Knight Commander of
the Royal Hanoverian Guelphic
Order, Governor and Command-
er in Chief in and over the
Island of Newfoundland and its
Dependencies, &c. &c.*

WHEREAS the GENERAL ASSEMBLY of this Island stands Pro-
rogued until Wednesday, the Fifteenth Day of October, inst :—
And Whereas I think fit further to prorogue the said General Assembly
until Thursday the 15th day of January next.

I do, therefore, by this my Proclamation, Prorogue the said GENERAL
ASSEMBLY until Thursday the 15th Day of January next, *then to meet for
the despatch of business* : And all Persons concerned are required and com-
manded to take due notice and govern themselves accordingly.

Given under my Hand and Seal, at the Gov-
ernment House, at St. John's, the 7th Day
of October, 1845, in the 9th Year of Her
Majesty's Reign.
