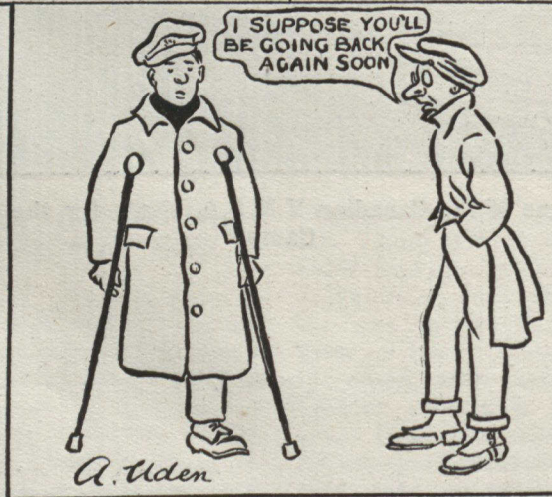


PTE. A. UDEN.
