

# CANADA IN THE DAYS TO COME WOULD BLESS GOD FOR RUSSIA, SAID SPEAKER AT BRANT THEATRE

### Rev. Mr. Hodgins at Recruiting Meeting Last Night Declared That Boundless Possibilities For Trade Expansion After the War Lay in Russia—New Sergt.-Major of the 215th Made Short Speech.

The recruiting meeting at the Brant Theatre last night was a short, snappy affair and was out at 9:45. The speaker of the evening was Rev. I. Hodgins who delivered an address, thoughtful in its tone and well calculated to sink into the minds of his hearers, and bring action later on. He emphasized one particularly interesting point in reference to Canada's relation to Russia. There were boundless trade possibilities for Canada in Russia, and if Canada helped Russia, then Russia would always give Canadians what they wanted.

Besides Mr. Hodgins, Sergt.-Major Salvaneschi of the 215th, made a short address, as did Col. Cutcliffe and Lt. Col. Harry Cockshutt. Col. Cutcliffe pointed out that the 125th still needed about 100 men and hoped to get them before the battalion moved to camp. Col. Cockshutt stated that he hoped the 125th would get its quota soon, and so get out of the way of the 215th. He made an appeal for both battalions but wanted the 125th to come first. "It's up to you, boys," he said, "Join up, and get a free trip to England and lots of action when you arrive there."

Before the speeches a thrilling war reel, "Two Little Britons" was shown. It depicted how Liege had been blown up by the Germans, and it elicited rounds of applause from the audience. The band of the 125th played on the platform and rendered a couple of selections in its usual pleasing style.

On the platform were Captain Sweet, Captain Andrews, Hon. Lt. Col. Cockshutt, M.P., Mr. Joseph Ruddy (chairman), Lt. Col. Cutcliffe, Lt. Col. Harry Cockshutt, Rev. Mr. Hodgins and Sergt.-Major Salvaneschi.

#### SRGT.-MAJOR SALVANESCHI.

"I am going to ask all you ladies to give up all their men folk," said Sergt.-Major Salvaneschi, who stated that that was the trouble in getting recruits. The women folk were holding the men back. Sergt.-Major Salvaneschi said he thought it was quite probable there would be danger from Germans in the United States. All men who joined would not necessarily go to France. Trained men might be needed to fight in Canada. "Come along and join the 215th and you will be treated like gentlemen," concluded the speaker at the close of his brief but spirited address.

#### REV. I. HODGINS.

Rev. Mr. Hodgins told of being in Germany near Dusseldorf in July, 1909, watching a Zeppelin being made a flight. He was in company with a young German, who had lived in France and England, and that German had told him that "There will be war in five years." Almost five years to a day, war broke out. That remark said Mr. Hodgins, was dropped as a friendly hint. He had lived in Germany before the war, and had been convinced that she was getting ready for war. Germans, to whom he had spoken in Germany, said Germany had no intention of war. Yet at all times she was preparing.

The German was an efficient soldier. Those people who thought Germany had reached the end of her tether, the new Germany. She was the most efficient war-like people that ever walked the planet, in point of organization. If it were merely man against man, and gun for gun, said Mr. Hodgins, he would despair of success. But when he thought of Germany, he thought of the unshakable determination of the Anglo-Saxon race, he plucked up heart again.

A high American official had told him, said Mr. Hodgins, that the United States could do nothing in this war as they did not know really where the country stood. "Look over the army and navy lists," said Mr. Hodgins, "and read the names of Germans there."

#### "SHOT-CIRCUITED" THE STAFF

Mr. Hodgins referred to an article in the NINETEENTH CENTURY, written by the commander-in-chief of the British forces in India. That brilliant soldier set down the things necessary to win a war, well-trained and high type of men, masses of guns, mountains of ammunition, and a general staff which must be absolute. "Short-circuited" with the general staff, "short-circuited" it, as the writer put it. Moreover, the Kaiser underestimated the power to "come back" the power

of reaction of the British people. "But he will not be beaten without a bloody struggle. The big fight is yet to come," declared Mr. Hodgins. Until she was crushed civilization was not safe.

"The young man who enlists carries with him a power almost impossible to exaggerate," said Mr. Hodgins. That was because he was the spiritual son of Shakespeare and Milton; because something of the divinity which Sir Philip Sydney was in his veins; because of Nelson and the Nile and because of their red line at Waterloo. It was because of this that the blood which made impossible for the young men of Canada to hide away.

#### A NEW WORLD.

The boys who went to the trenches were fighting for the Kingdom of God, for a spiritual vision, for a new England, a new France, a new Russia, a new Canada. Germany had accepted a civilization based on brute force with scientific means working for extermination. Unless we at this crisis supported Britain the world would last too long. "I appeal to you young men to join now and end this war quickly," declared Mr. Hodgins.

Canada, geographically, was the key between East and West. Russia, an enormous country with 200 millions of a homogeneous population, was incredibly rich in gold. What would happen to Canada if Russia were crushed? Canada would lose her trade. The day might come, declared the speaker, when Canada would thank God for Russia. Russia was not barbarian. She gave the world the best of music and literature in the 19th century.

If Canada upheld the arm of Russia in this war, trade possibilities for her in Russia would be boundless. Everything would be thrown open to Canadians in Russia. Why? Because Canadian stood by Russia, stood by the big brother when she up held the little brother in keeping her free from tyranny.
