M'ELROY WINS CARLETON.

Has Over 600 Majority Over Independent Conservative.

Ottawa, March 19.—R. H. McElroy of Carleton was elected to fill the vacancy in Carleton County for the Ontario Legislature caused by the death of G. N. Kidd. He was the official Conservative candidate against W. H. Hartin, Independent Conservative.

Five polls were to be heard from. There was a bigger vote polled yesterday than at the general election, when the late G. N. Kidd won by 1,179 over J. Smith, Liberal. The figures now stand: R. H. McElroy, 1,477; W. H. Hartin, 860. Majority, 617.

What Provinces Get.

Ottawa, March 18.—Under the provisions of the new act governing the granting of provincial subsidies by the Dominion, of which notice has been given by Sir Wilfrid Laurier, the increases to the various provinces, on the basis of the last census returns, will be as follows: Ontario, \$789,486; Quebec, \$599,866; Nova Scotia, \$177,659; New Brunswick, \$150,000; Manitoba, \$142,530; British Columbia, \$205,000; Prince Edward Island, \$65,340; Alberta, \$48,329; Saskatchewan, \$136,219.

Among the new spring colors is rosewood, a mingling of brown and

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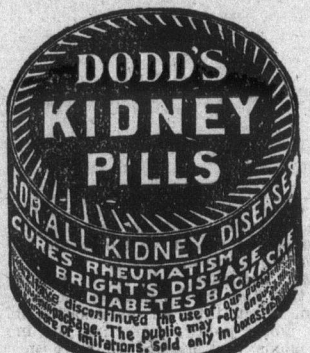
