Don't load your truck beyond it normal rated capacity. It was designed and built to carry that load. Cer tainly it may carry more, but this tice invites inevitable loss. To that your trucks are overloaded is merely another way of saying that you are mat erally shortening their useful life as well as decreasing their range of activity.

An overload increases the stresse in the weight carrying members, may cause excessive breakage of these

In any good truck, normal weight, hence normal stress, produce normal wear of moving parts. An excess will necess arily result in abnormal or excessive

A truck frame and other parts may be compared to a bridge. When a bridge tons, it mean rated at so many that load with that it can carry a certain margin of safety. It will carry more, but the margin of safety which was provided to take care of its depreciation in normal service will not be as large. The same is true of the truck.

Overloading decreases the ability of the truck to negotiate road conditions since there is a greater weight to be moved per unit of engine power. A result is excessive gasoline cor and slower operating speed; therefore greatly reduced efficiency.


