With Men in the Political Life of Sweden.

Stockholm, Jan. 16.—Women henceforth are to take a full and equal share with men in the political life of Sweden. The speech from the throne at the opening of the Riksdag today contained the announcement that a bill was to be introduced enfranchising women and making them eligible at the elections of the Riksdag on the same conditions as men. Every Swede over 21 years old, not under legal disability, has the right to vote for members of the second chamber.
