

Stewart alleged that when he returned from overseas he made certain domestic discoveries, and, therefore, felt himself justified in remarrying without the formality of a divorce. His counsel, Fletcher Kerr, argued divorce in Canada was only for the rich. His plea was of no avail, however, and Col. Denison decreed that he should go to the Ontario Reformatory indefinitely, the sentence to be not less than one year and not more than two years less one day.


