

Fishes Eggs Vary Greatly

SOME FLOAT FREELY WHILE OTHERS SINK TO BOTTOM.
You know those old, black, purse-

They really are the empty shells of eggs of dog fish or the skates, and of eggs of dog fish or the skates, and the tendrils were originally useful in attacking the eggs to the stalk of some seaweed. The dog-fish does not lay so many eggs as do other fish, and since these take a long time to hatch—some as much as ten months—it is quite necessary that they should be placed in a safe place, and not left to drift at the mercy of every current.

All the fish of the shark family, to which the skates belong, lay these odd, horny-shelled eggs; but most other fish lay round eggs, which have not the same means of attachment to weeds or to the bottom. Some are heavier than water, and therefore sink to the bottom; others float.

NESTING PISH.

The eggs of the salmon are a good example of heavy eggs. They lie on the bottom in hollows in gravel scooped by the parent fish. Cod's eggs also float, but the eggs of the herring float to the bottom of the sea.

Salmon eggs lie separate, one from another, and so do those of trout and char, but the eggs of are attached to one another in long ribands. The egg of the roach are sticky, and when laid they sink to the bottom and attach themselves to roots and other objects, themselves to roots and other objects.

Eels devour great numbers of them, and possibly not one in a thousand hatches out.
