LARGE MARKET BUT FEATURELESS

Not Much of Demand for Anything This Morning.

HAY IS \$10 TO \$11 TON

Fair Supply of Berries and Greens, and Prices Remain Unchanged.

This morning's market, although fairly large, was featureless, prices remaining stagnant, while the demand was ordinary, in practically all lines. Hay had the greatest run of the offerings, and the few loads brought in were picked up by the buyers before the owners had been on the stand five minutes. The price for the new product is still \$10 to \$11, according to quality. But one load of straw was brought in. It was purchased last week for \$7, but had the owner brought it in for sale this morning he could have realized much more money. Oats are now worth \$1.73 to \$1.77 per hundred, while wheat is quoted at \$1.15 to \$1.25. Fresh eggs wholesale at 20c to 21c a dozen, and retail at 22c to 24c. Roll butter is worth 21c to 22c a pound. There has been little change in the price of butchers' meats recently, and beef is now going at \$6.50 to \$6.75 to \$8 a hundred by the carcass.

There was a fair supply of berries and green stuff, and the prices being practically unchanged.
