WIDE RANGE OF PRICE
IN BUTTER OFFERINGS

Eighteen to Twenty-Eight
Cents—Hay and Oats
Maintain High Level.

Today's market was the usual Saturday
one, good prices prevailing in nearly all
lines.

Butter varied in price all the way from
50c for stone lots to 25c and 20c a dozen.
Eggs wholesaled at 15c and 20c a dozen,
and retail at 22c.

Monday being a holiday, there will be
no market for live hogs.

Oats are still greatly in demand, and
bring readily enough \$1.16 per cwt.

Hay sells as high as \$17 a ton.
Potatoes this morning sold at \$1.15 a
bag wholesale, and \$1.20 to \$1.25 retail.

Winnipeg, May 22.—Wheat market
opened unchanged to 10c lower today. Liver-
pool cables were firmer than expected in
view of the sharp break of Thursday, and
with no new developments in the winter
wheat belt and spring wheat conditions
being favorable, a further dip occurred
following the closing. The market
showed strong later, and wheat advanced
in sympathy, weakening again at the
close. Futures closed 3c lower for all
months.

The cash demand was quiet for all
grades except for No. 2 and 3 northern
wheat, and a fairly active inquiry for No. 1
Canadian western oats for export.

Winnipeg cash wheat closed 3c to 1c
for contract grades; oats, 3c to 1c
higher; barley, 3c to 1c higher; and
flax, 3c lower for all grades.
