Peru Antagonistic to Chili.

LIMA, Nov. 26 .- The correspondent of the United Press has been making inquiries here with a view of ascertaining the public sentiment in Peru relative to any difficulties between Peru and the United States. So far as the correspondent could ascertain, the sentiment of Peru is decidedly favorable to the Americans and hostile to Chili. There is a Americans and hostile to Chili. There is a decided reluctance on the part of the public officials to give utterance to their views for publication, but the speech of nearly everybody in private life, including men influential in every circle of business, is of deep and lasting animosity to the sister republic. One of the leading bankers in Lima said the United States could do nothing man acquisited for an propagative in South more calculated to gain popularity in South America than to give Chill a lesson, espe-cially if the lesson should be accompanied cially if the lesson should be accompanied by an act of justice to Peru, in returning the nitrate district to the Peruvians. "If the Chilians," said the speaker, "had been victors in civilized warfare, we could have victors in civilized warfare, we could have forgiven them; but they treated us barbarously. They destroyed our property in mere wantonness and made the country a desert wherever they went. Their real motive in going to war was to get the nitrate away from us, and they tried to weaken us so that we should never be able to recover it. Peru has no desire to get into war with Chili, but if the United States should make war on that country it States should make war on that country it would have substantial sympathy from Peru." While the country has just recovered, in some degree, from the Chilan conquest, the signs of devastation wrought are still visible everywhere.

The Newfoundland Balt Act. NEW YORK, Nov. 26. - A special to the Mail and Express from Ottawa, says the Dominion Government is advised that the law officers of the Imperial Government have declared the Newfoundland Bait Act to be unconstitutional. Canada and Newfoundland, it has been proposed, shall submit a joint case to the Imperial Privy Council. If Newfoundland refuses, the British authorities can, nevertheless, make a reference under an Imperial statute. The obnoxious act was passed by the Newfoundland legislature in 1889. It prohibits the sale of fresh fish, which includes bait, to foreign fishermen. The act was allowed by the Imperial Government on condition that its provisions would not apply to the Canadians. Subsequently the Newfoundland authorities rescinded this concession, only giving this concession to American fishermen.
