SHIPWRECKED FOUR TIMES.

Bayoneted in Battle, Hit by a Train and Yet Lives.

Mr. J. Cousins, the one-armed news agent, who has a little wooden stand at the corner of Queen street and Spadina avenue, was let out of the Western hospital yesterday morning.

Mr. Cousins has had quite an eventful career. Following the loss of an arm bayoneted in battle, once struck by a train, losing an eye, part of his skull, an arm and shoulderblade; four times having his ribs broken, once breaking his right ankle, and once falling on his left leg, are accidents that every man does not survive; yet Mr. Cousins has lived to see all these, and still papers at the corner of Queen street and Spadina avenue.

It is thirty-one years since Mr. Cousins was a ship carpenter on the St. George, which sailed upon the Mediterranean and returned to the island of Corsica, where he was captured by the French.
