PARADISE.

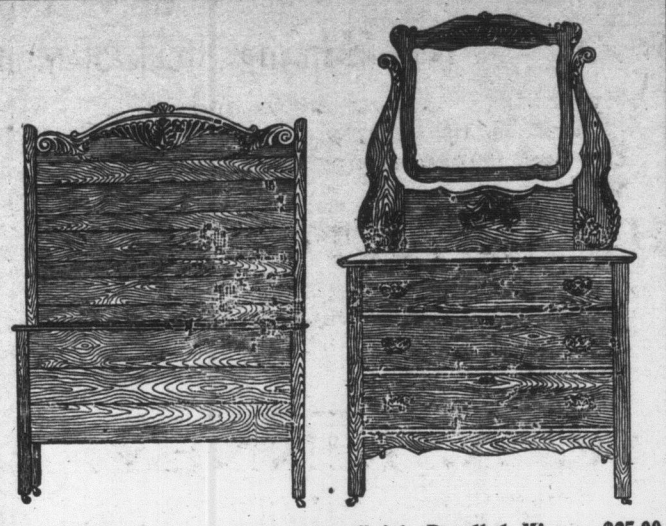
A meeting of the Agricultural Society will be held on Saturday evening, 14th inst.

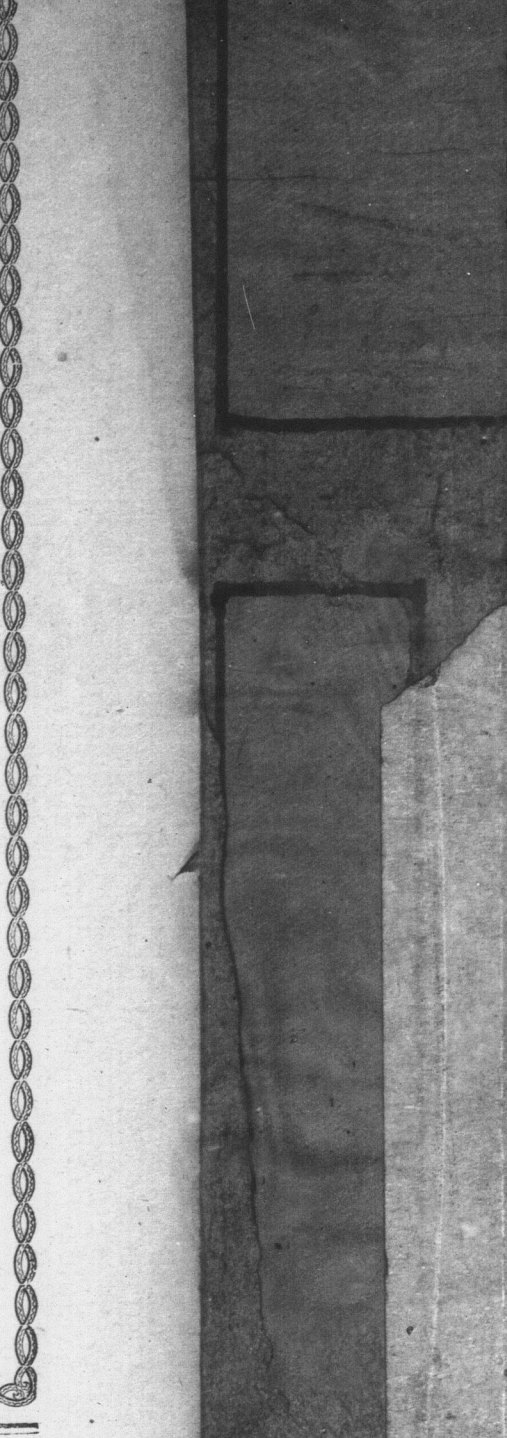
