

INTRODUCTION

This quarterly report of the Trade and Industrial Development Program covers the period from July 1991 through July 1992 and contains information derived from the Trade Program Tracking Component of the Planning and Tracking System. The report is based on the reports that were available as of July 4, 1992. From a total of 1,000 reports, 100 reports are included in this report.

There are two main sections in this report:

Section I summarizes the following components of the program results summary: one for each trade region and one for "All Regions". In a global summary, each page summarizes a separate region.

Section II provides a summary and highlights of each activity.

Section III provides an update and investment summary.

Section IV provides a status report.

Section I, titled as "Summary Report" for each region and its respective goals, is broken down into sections throughout this section, regardless of the level of geographic aggregation. Activity in these reports is broken down into Trade Program activity (Table A through H) and non-trade activity in other mission programs (Table K). For each activity, there is the location of the average time spent on the Trade Program by Canada-based and foreign-based trade promotion officers. There is also a total time allocation for each activity which is used as an indicator of program effort. Person-weeks for each region are also provided by activity. Person-weeks are also included in this report.
