- viability support — up to \$100 000; and
- project support — up to \$500 000.

Professional Services

The services-oriented programs help eligible organizations (e.g. consulting firms, financial institutions and business associations) to conduct studies and provide professional guidance and advice to potential clients in developing countries.

Assistance is available through five mechanisms:

- capital project preliminary study — up to \$350 000;
- capital project detailed study — up to \$500 000;
- capital project support — up to \$500 000;
- industrial plant rehabilitation — up to \$500 000; and
- industrial planning and development — up to \$500 000.
