PRAYERS.

Mr. Kierans, a Member of the Queen's Privy Council, laid upon the Table, —Copies of Report entitled "Communications Canada—Participation by Telecommunications Carriers in Public Data-Processing".—(English and French)—Sessional Paper No. 4/66.

Mr. Marchand (Langelier), seconded by Mr. Pepin, by leave of the House, introduced Bill C-222, An Act to authorize the making of a grant to the Province of Nova Scotia for the purpose of providing assistance to Deuterium of Canada Limited, which was read the first time and ordered to be printed and ordered for a second reading at the next sitting of the House.

The text of the Message and recommendation of the Governor General printed pursuant to Standing Order 62(2) in relation to the foregoing Bill is as follows:

His Excellency the Governor General recommends to the House of Commons a measure to provide for the making of a grant of five million dollars out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund to the province of Nova Scotia for the purpose of providing assistance to Deuterium of Canada Limited; and the conditions thereof.
