As at January 31, 1959, the agricultural stabilization board held the following stocks:

Butter	69,682,444 pounds
Dry skimmed milk	65,126,606 pounds
Cheese	1,205,883 pounds
Shell eggs	75,541 cases
Fowl	832,254 pounds
Canned tomatoes	101,924 cases
Pork products	16,150,361 pounds

Present stocks held by the board are not necessarily surplus since substantial quantities of many products will be resold in the

domestic market during periods of low seasonal production.
