the Governor General is owned by the Government and two private railway cars are on loan from Canadian National. (b) Car 5; Car 53, Northwind. (c) Records are retained only one full year. Since April 1, 1974 Car 5 has travelled 25,269 miles and Car 53 has travelled 28,894 miles. (d) \$1.95 per mile. (e) Total cost to Transport Canada since April 1, 1974 is \$150,600.
