divided into separate categories. That is the way they should be dealt with. I find it ironic that sexual orientation should always be lumped in with the physically handicapped. I often wonder what they think about being in the same category. The report quite properly deals with different problems under different categories.

The physically handicapped are under 1.1.1, sexual orientation under 1.2.1 and political belief under 1.2.2 dealing with

the physically handicapped. I assure my hon. friend that the government is serious. I will jog his memory a bit. The Speech from the Throne said, "There will be amendments to protect the rights of the handicapped". I will rephrase that. It said, "Amendments to protect the right of the handicapped will be made to the Human Rights Act". That is fairly unequivocal.
