
QUEBEC EMIGRANT SOCIETY.

At a PUBLIC MEETING of the SUBSCRIBERS to the QUEBEC EMIGRANT SOCIETY, to which the Inhabitants in general were invited by Advertisement, and by handbills, held by permission in the READING ROOM of the NEW EXCHANGE, on MONDAY, APRIL 23d, 1832:—

The Honorable Mr. JUSTICE KERR, President, having been called upon to take the Chair, stated that the object for which the Meeting had been summoned was to submit to the Subscribers generally the REPORT of the COMMITTEE of MANAGEMENT, on resigning their charge; and to proceed to the Election of New Officers, and a new Committee, who, in future years, would go into office on the first MONDAY in MAY, according to the provisions of certain new Regulations, which he should have the honor of submitting for the adoption of the Meeting.

The SECRETARY then presented the REPORT of the COMMITTEE of MANAGEMENT, since the 2d February, 1832, the date of their former Report.

The REPORT having been read, it was RESOLVED, That the REPORT of the COMMITTEE of MANAGEMENT be received, and placed upon the minutes of the Society.

The said REPORT was in the following words:—
