- 10. The property of the Society shall be vested in three trustees, who shall be elected each year at the Annual General Meeting.
- 11. At any regular meeting, upon four weeks' notice having been given, as provided in Section 21, the formation of a section dealing with any branch of scientific study or historical research coming within the meaning of the "objects" of the Society, as defined in Section 2 of this Constitution, may, upon resolution, be authorized, and a member of the Society may be selected by the President to act as chairman and organizer of such section.

OFFICERS

12. The Officers of the Society shall be elected by ballot at the annual meeting, and shall consist of:

President;

Two Vice-Presidents;

Secretary;

Treasurer;

Two Auditors, who shall audit all accounts of the Society and report thereon at the annual meeting.

These officers shall be ex officiis members of the Executive Committee.
