

New Catalogue of Weights, Measures, &c.

ACRE, 160 square poles; 4840 square yards.

ANKER, 10 gallons of brandy.

BAG, 1 bushel of lime; 3 cwt. of almonds, and 4 of currants.

BALE, 100 bolts of Paris and Lyons thread; $\frac{1}{2}$ cwt. of cochineal and indigo; 2 of cardamoms and thrown silk; 2 and $\frac{1}{2}$ of Spanish wool; 3 of carraway seeds; 6 of safflower; 20 pieces of bolts; 2 and $\frac{1}{2}$ of bevirnix and holmes fustians; 10 reams of paper.

BARREL, 31 and $\frac{1}{2}$ gallons of oil and wine; 32 of ale, herrings and ling; 36 of beer; 42 of eels, mumm and salmon; 3 bushels of apples, pears and nuts; 1 cwt. of gunpowder, lipora and raisins; 10 lb. of anchovies; 120 lb. of candles; 200 lb. of pot-ashes and oat-meal; 224 lb. of butter; 240 or 250 lb. of soap; 300 of plates; 200 of herrings and stockfish.

BUNDLE, 3 feet (about at the head) of basket rods; one sixtieth of a load of bulrushes; 10 necklaces, gloves' knives, harness-plates, and bass ropes; 100 laths 5 feet long, 120 laths 4 feet long; 20 skains of Hamburg yarn; 2 reams of paper.

BUSHEL, 4 pecks dry measure, or 5 pecks water measure.

BUTT, 3 barrels of beer and ale; 2 hogheads of wine.

CASE, 45 tables of glass; 25 of Newcastle and Normandy glass.

CARAT, 24 grains of gold; 4 of diamonds, pearls, &c.

CAROTHEL, 3 cwt. of mace.

CASK, 2 cwt. of wheat flour, and 3 of almonds.

CHALDER, 4 quarters of corn.

CHALDRON, 32 bushels of corn; 36 of coals.

CUBIT, 1 foot and a half.

DEGREE, 60 geographical miles; 69 and $\frac{1}{2}$ statute miles.

DICKER, 10 hides; 10 pair of gloves.

DOZEN, generally 12 of any thing; but 23 of tanned calskins; and 14 of rolls.

DRAM, 3 scruples.

ELL, Flemish, 3 quarters of a yard; Scotch, 4 quarters and 10ths of an inch; English, 5 quarters; French 6.

FANGOT, 1 and $\frac{1}{2}$ cwt. of thrown silk of Naples.

FATHOM, a measure of 6 feet.
