

Declaring the Cessation of Arms, as well by the United States of America and His Britannic Majesty, and

By which said Preliminary Articles it hath been agreed, That so long as the same were ratifi-
Subjects, should cease in all Parts of the World; and as hath been agreed, That all Vessels and
after the Space of Twelve Days from the Ratification of the said Preliminary Articles, should be
and North Seas as far as the Canary Islands inclusively, whether in the Ocean or in the Mediterrane-
tial Line or Equator; and lastly, Five Months in all other Parts of the World, without any Ex-
whereas it was declared, by the Minister Plenipotentiary of the King of Great Britain, in the
Twentieth Day of January last, that the said United States of America, their Subjects and their
Arms, at the same Epochs, and in the same Manner, as the Three Crowns above mentioned, and
the Part and in the Name of the United States of America, a similar Declaration shall be deliver-
and containing an Assurance, that the said Government will observe this Part. And whereas the
